Day 1 Hong Kong / Kathmandu (Alt. 1400m)

Depart Hong Kong with a direct flight to Kathmandu. Greet at the airport and transfer to check in at hotel. Free and overnight

Day 2 Kathmandu – City Tour (Breakfast)

After breakfast at hotel, Have a **full day sightseeing in Kathmandu**. Visit one of the famous Hindu temple, Pashupatinath (which is listed in UNESCO world heritage site) and the Boudhanath (Buddhist stupa). After lunch visit the old city of Bhaktapur. Back to hotel at late afternoon. Lunch and Dinner is on guest own account. Free and overnight at hotel.

Day 3 Kathmandu / Pokhara (Alt.884m) – Birethanti (Alt. 1040m)

After breakfast at hotel. Check out and transfer to airport. **Take domestic flight to Pokhara**.

Upon arrival, meet at the airport and drive for about 2hrs to Birethanti a small village set at the foot of the Modi Khola Valley. Walk around the area to get ready for the trek. Meals provided and overnight at Lodge.

Day 4 Birethanti – Ghandruk (Alt. 2012m) (3- 4 hrs trek)

Today, start with your first day trek for about 3-4hrs ascending to **Ghandruk**. In the shadow of the Annapurna overlooks Ghandruk, once a popular recruitment location for the Gurkha soldier regiment. Meals provided. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 5 Ghandruk

In the morning, **enjoy spectacular views of Mt Annapurna South and Mt Fishtail**. Walk around, take nice photo shots of the Himalayan range and numerous sights of villages agricultural terrace fields. Afternoon visit a Ghandruk village. Meals provided. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 6 Ghandruk – Birethanti (3 – 4 hrs trek)

Today descending to **Birethanti**, for around 4 hrs walk. Meals provided. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 7 Birethanti – Majgaon (Alt. 1400m) (4 hrs trek)

Today trek for about 4hrs to **Majgaon**. On route, enjoy the views of surrounding valleys and provides excellent photographic opportunities. Meals provided. Overnight stay at Lodge.

Day 8 Majgaon - Dhampus (Alt, 1525m) (4 hrs trek)

Today walk for about 4hrs to **Dhampus**. On route, **enjoy the panoramic views of the Phedi and Mardi Valleys**. Have a nature walks through thick forests of bamboo, conifer and rhododendrons. Meals provided. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 9 Dhampus – Phedi (4 hrs trek) – Pokhara

Today walk to Phedi for about 4hrs. On arrival, meet by our driver and **drive to Pokhara** (60mins).

Check in at Hotel. Dinner on guest own account. Overnight at hotel.

Day 10 Pokhara / Kathmandu / Hong Kong

Breakfast at hotel, check out and transfer to airport for **domestic flight to Kathmandu**.

Meet at the airport and transfer to have **city tour around the streets of Thamel**. Dinner is on guest own account.

After dinner transfer to airport for departure flight. Take late evening flight to Hong Kong

TIBET – situated in Tibetan Plateau, an autonomous region of China with its nick name “**Roof of the World**” for its towering peaks of Himalayas shared **Mt. Everest** with Nepal. **Lhasa** – the capital of the Region, lies on the Lhasa River in a valley of the Himalayas. The **Potala Palace** once served as the winter home of the Dalai Lama. The landmark of the city at 3700m above sea level. It is the greatest monument in Tibet and listed as one of the UNESCO site.

Yamdrok Lake is a freshwater lake in Tibet, one of the three largest sacred lakes in Tibet. The lake is surrounded by many snow-capped mountains and is fed by numerous small streams, around 110kms from Lhasa city.

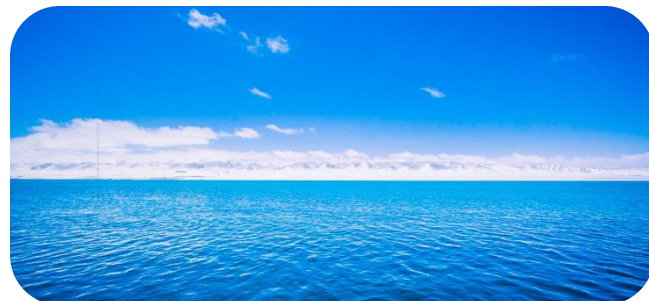


Shigatse – the second largest city in Tibet, with an area of 182,000 km². It is located within the historical Tsang province, it is only 300kms from the Mt Everest National Park.

Tashi Lhunpo Monastery, one of the six Gelug monasteries is the seat of successive Panchen Lamas. Founded by the First Dalai Lama in 1447 is a historic and culturally important monastery in Shigatse.

QINGHAI is a large, sparsely populated province across the high-altitude Tibetan Plateau, has the mixed culture mixed of Tibetans and Mongols. Amne Machin peak of the Kunlun Mountain range, is a holy site for Buddhist pilgrims.

Qinghai Lake – the largest lake in China with a surface area of over 4,500 square kilometers. This scenic lake is surrounded with characteristic islands, vast grasslands and snowy mountains, it is now one of popular tourist destination.

10 DAYS **Urumqi / Kashgar / Tashkorgan (Karakorum Highway) / Turpan / Dunhuang**

Saturday Hong Kong / Beijing / Urumqi / Kashgar

Depart Hong Kong in the morning to Kashgar via Beijing and Urumqi
Meet and transfer to check in at hotel in Kashgar . Free and overnight.

Sunday Kashgar

After breakfast at hotel, visit the Id Kah mosque – it covering area of 16800 sq. meters and is the largest mosques in China. Then visit to Tomb of Abakhja family – located about 5 kilometers of the city of Kashgar, it is also known as the tomb of Fragrant Concubine. Continue excursion to Sunday Bazaar including animal market and visiting an Uygur family. Lunch & dinner provided at local restaurants. Overnight at hotel.

Monday Kashgar – Karakuli Lake – Tashkorgan

After breakfast at hotel. Check out. Morning drive to Karakul lake – 3 hrs drive, on the way visiting white sand Lake and excursion at the Karakul Lake side and experience the life of local Kirgiz herdsmen and then further drive to Tashkorgan county – 2 hrs via the Karakorum Highway (Pamir Plateau) which is considered as one of the most scenic highway in the world and have a visit to Tajik Nationality family.

Lunch & dinner provided at local restaurants. Check in the hotel and overnight .

Tuesday Mile Stone Alt. 3800m – Kashgar / Urumqi

Breakfast at hotel. Morning visit the Stone city ruins and the border (Mile stone – Alt 3800m) between China & Pakistan and Tajik nationality gallery, and then drive back to Kashgar and have dinner at local restaurant. Then directly drive to airport. Take the domestic flight to Urumqi.

Upon arrive, Meet and transfer to check in at the hotel. Free and overnight at hotel. Lunch & dinner provided at local restaurants.

Wednesday Urumqi – Heavenly Lake

After breakfast drive to Heavenly Lake around 90mins take a pleasure boat and experience the life of local Kazakh herdsmen. Lunch provided at local restaurant. Afternoon visiting the Regional Museum including its mummies hall, and excursion to Erdaoqiao International Grand Bazaar . Dinner provided at local restaurant. Back to hotel and overnight.

Thursday Urumqi – Turpan

After breakfast at hotel, check out and drive to Turpan (200kms – 3 hrs). Arrive Turpan and have lunch at local restaurant, afternoon visit the Gaochang ancient ruin city by donkey cart ride. Then continue visit the Bezelik Thousand Buddha Cave, Astana ancient tomb and the flaming mountain. Dinner provided at local restaurant with cultural show. Back to hotel after sightseeing.

Friday Turpan – Liuyuan (by train)

After breakfast, visit the Jiaohe Old Town, Kerezi Irrigation System and Lining Minaret. Afternoon visit the Turpan Museum and its bazaar. Lunch & dinner provided at local restaurants. Transfer to train station (60kms) at late evening. Take the overnight train to Liuyuan (soft berth).

Saturday Liuyuan – Dunhuang

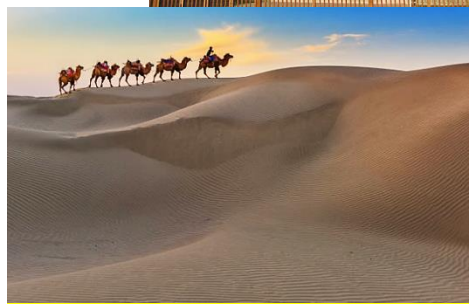
Arrive Liuyuan station and transfer to Dunhuang city and check-in at the hotel in Dunhuang. Lunch provided in local restaurant. Afternoon visit the Dunhuang Museum, White Horse Pagoda and visit to the Sand Dunes in Mingshashan , experience the sand dune and view the sunset in the desert. Have dinner at local restaurants before back to hotel. Free and overnight.

Sunday Dunhuang

Pre-dawn take the camel ride towards Ming Sha Shan (desert) and enjoy the sunrise view from the desert. Return to hotel for breakfast, then have a day tour to visit the Mogao Buddhism Grottoes and visit to surrounding areas. Overnight at Hotel.

Monday Dunhuang / Beijing / Hongkong

Breakfast at hotel, check out and transfer to airport.
Depart Dunhuang and take a flight back to Hong Kong via Beijing

Thimphu / Punakha / Gantey / Paro

8 Days / 7 Nights CLASSIC TOUR

Day 1 Bangkok – Overnight

Due to the flight departure to Bhutan are mostly early in the morning, So overnight in Bangkok suggested.

Day 2 Bangkok / Paro - Thimphu

Take morning flight to Paro (with a stop in India) crosses the Himalaya Mountains, affording spectacular views of the awesome peaks, including the sacred Jumolhari and Jichu Drake peaks in Bhutan. Upon arrival in Paro, you will be greeted by our representative and transferred directly to Paro and have lunch. Then drive to Thimphu and visit the **King's Memorial Chorten** (built in memory of the third King of Bhutan who reigned from 1952-1972), **Changgangkha Monastery**, the radio tower (for a great view of Thimphu Valley and the Thimphu Dzong), and the zoo, which contains the national animal of Bhutan – **Takin**. Check in at a local 3 stars hotel, dinner provided and overnight.

Day 3 Thimphu – Punakha

Breakfast at hotel. This morning, visit a nunnery temple, the **National Library** (which houses ancient manuscripts), and the School of Arts and Crafts (also known as the painting school). visit the National Institute of Traditional Medicine, a traditional paper factory, the majestic **Tashichodzong**, and **Simtokha Dzong** (the oldest fortress in the kingdom). Afternoon drive to Punakha – the former capital of Bhutan, with a stop en route for tea break at Dochu La (3,100 meters), where you may enjoy a spectacular view of the Himalayas on a clear day. On arrival, check in at hotel – 3 stars local.

Dinner and overnight.

Day 4 Punakha

Breakfast at hotel, Full day visit in Punakha, enjoy a short hike around 3 hrs to visit **Khamsum Yulley Namgyal Chorten** through a trail from the village, the unique temple is situated up on the mountain. Walk down through the trail and enjoy the valley view of Punakha.

Afternoon visit the Punakha Dzong, which is noteworthy both for being one of the most beautiful dzongs in Bhutan and also for having been built by the first Shabdrung in 1637. On the way back, stop at Metshina Village and take walk through the rice fields to **Chimi Lhakhang**, which is a fertility temple. Back to hotel, free and overnight

Day 5 Punakha – Gantey –Punakha

After breakfast, day visit to Gantey. Passing through the dense forests of oak trees and rhododendrons and arrive at Gantey village, where you'll visit **Gantey Gompa**, the only **Nyingmapa monastery** in western Bhutan. From Gantey, you can see the picturesque Black Mountain range as well as Phobjika Valley, the winter habitat of the black-necked cranes. Then drive back to Punakha, free and overnight.

Note: If you are traveling to Bhutan from Nov to Feb, you may have chance to spot the Black-necked Cranes from Tibet. Bhutan has taken special care to protect this species and has established the Phobjikha Conservation Area for them and its hunting is prohibited.

Day 6 Punakha – Paro

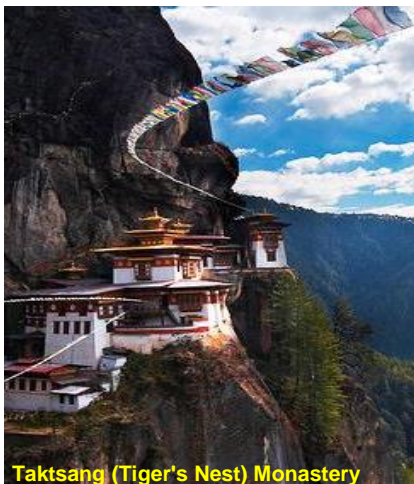
Morning drive to Paro via Thimphu. On arrival check in at a local 3 stars hotel. In the afternoon you will visit the **Paro Dzong**. It was built in 1646 and now houses government offices and religious institutions, as do all the dzongs (forts) currently. **Ta Dzong National Museum**, which houses a wide collection of fine arts, paintings, statues, and antiques. In the evening, stroll around Paro market and town. Overnight in Paro.

Day 7 Paro

After breakfast, hike to **Taktsang (Tiger's Nest) Monastery**, which is Bhutan's most famous monastery. It is perched on the edge of a steep cliff, about 900 meters above Paro Valley. Then hike to reach the viewpoint to the monastery which makes a nice half-day excursion. After lunch, visit a farm house and share sometimes with the local family to know more about lifestyle of Bhutanese.

Day 8 Paro / Bangkok

Early morning transfer to airport. Take the morning flight to Bangkok, you may like to layover in Bangkok or connect flight to Hongkong.

South Island 13 Days / 10 Nights

Christchurch / Greymouth / Franz Josef / Queenstown

Day 1 Hong Kong / Auckland

Take the evening flight to Auckland. Overnight on board.

Day 2 Auckland / Christchurch - Free

Morning arrive. After the immigration, claim your luggage's and take the shuttle bus at airport to Domestic Terminal. Connect with Domestic flight to Christchurch

Upon arrival in Christchurch Airport, look out for your driver who will have your name on a board at the exit of the arrivals hall and transfer to check in your confirmed hotel. Free and overnight at hotel. Lunch and dinner on your own account.

Day 3 Christchurch - East Coast Whale Watch

Breakfast at hotel. Pick up by your guide in the morning at hotel.

Spend the day getting close to nature on a whale-watching day trip to Kaikoura, renowned for its variety of marine mammals. You'll enjoy a scenic drive through the rolling hill country of North Canterbury, go on a whale-watching boat tour from Kaikoura, visit a seal colony and complete the day with a wine tasting at a local vineyard. On your whale-watching cruise from beautiful Kaikoura, where the mountains meet the sea, you might spot giant sperm whales, acrobatic dusky dolphins, seals and royal albatross. After lunch at a local restaurant, you'll visit a seal colony to view fur seals at close quarters. On your return journey to Christchurch you'll stop at a North Canterbury vineyard where a wine tasting has been arranged for your pleasure. Back to hotel at late afternoon, free and overnight.

Day 4 Christchurch (Free Day)

Breakfast at hotel. Free Day on your own arrangement, any activities or tours today are at your own additional expense. There are many things to do in Christchurch depending on your energy level. Lunch and dinner on your own account.

Day 5 Christchurch - Train Journey through the Southern Alps

Breakfast at hotel. Check out and transfer to train station, take the Tranz-Alpine Train. 08:15 departs towards Wild West Coast. It rated as one of the worlds 6 best train journeys. Leaving from Christchurch, crossing the huge and fertile patchwork farmlands of the Canterbury Plains, the Tranz-Alpine winds its way over massive viaducts, through spectacular gorges and river valleys, before tracking across the country's greatest mountain range, the Southern Alps. Following rivers and skirting lakes, it descends through lush rainforest to the Tasman Sea and the town of Greymouth. 14:05 arrive in Greymouth Railway Station, met by your hotel courtesy vehicle. Meet near the baggage claim area next to their shuttle vehicle and transfer to check in the hotel. Pick up at hotel for your afternoon tour. Will travel from Greymouth north along the stunning Coast Road to Punakaiki, being the Maori word for "Food Basket" and the home of the fascinating Pancake Rocks. As near as possible to high tide take a stroll around the Pancake Rocks Walkway to see the unique rock structures layered here 30 million years ago. Watch also for the roaring Geysers that heave their way from the Ocean floor up out through the Rock Blowholes. Walk along a secluded beach beside the thundering Tasman Sea surf in a search for your own souvenir piece of this treasured gemstone. Back to hotel, free and overnight. Lunch and dinner on your own account.

Day 6 Greymouth - Blackwater rafting then off to the Glaciers

07:30 Take 10 minutes walk from your hotel to McDonalds. 8 Whall Street, Greymouth
08:00 Report to Blackwater Cave raft-Tubing Adventure Centre
A fun adventure with a touch of mystery and intrigue, floating through an underground galaxy world of glow-worms, experiencing the fun of rainforest river tubing. This is a relaxing, fun half day adventure experiencing some Maori Cave Legends, is in a beautiful place and takes you into an unusual cave environment with it's glow-worms.

RENTED CAR

Walk from the Thrifty Depot in Greymouth which is in the same office as the finish point of the morning trip. Drive to Franz Josef - you will pass through small towns on the way which are famous for their Jade carvings and gold. Hokitika & Ross might be worth a stop as well as lake lanthe - right past the Bushman's Centre which is worth stopping at, watch out for those creepy bush insects and the wild pig. The driving is around 3 hrs. Upon arrival, check in to hotel and overnight.

Day 7 Glacier Heli Hike

Early breakfast at hotel. Drive to Glacier guides Building.

08:30 Check-in at the Glacier Guides Building on the Main Road in Franz Josef. You are in a small village so things are easy to find and you will see the sign on their base building. They may want to change your flight time to make use of a break in the weather. We will check and make any changes in arrangements for you. Drive back to your holiday House after the tour. It is an unique, very educational and a lot of fun.

14:30 Pick up at the holiday house for an organized off road Quad farm bike Adventure this afternoon. Overnight at the Farm House.

Day 8 Franz Josef - Christchurch

Breakfast at hotel. This day drive to Queenstown - Approx. 5 hours driving time. Travel on through the spectacular West Coast scenery. This is a land of contrasts with majestic mountains on one side of the road and a rugged untamed coast on the other. View penguins and seals that are resident to this coast line. (Seasonal) You will pass some lakes left by the ice melt of retreating glaciers. One of these is lake Moeraki. The river that comes from this lake leads to the coast which is well known for it's penguin colony.

Visit on route to the thundering waterfalls at the Haast Pass area with some great photo opportunities. We recommend a stop at the Conservation Haast Visitor Centre which is the main road. It is well sign posted. Finish the day in Queenstown. Upon arrival check in at hotel and overnight

Day 9 Helicopter flight to Milford Sound and Cruise

Breakfast at hotel. Take the Helicopter flight to Milford Sound. Milford Sound is often described as the eighth wonder of the world. It is set in the Fiordland National Park, on the west coast of the South Island. Taking the magnificent Milford Sound flight option above, upon landing in Milford join the Mitre Peak Cruise, an exploratory nature cruise on the sound. View cascading waterfalls, sheer rock faces and unique wildlife, voyage out past St Anne's lighthouse to the Tasman Sea before re-boarding your helicopter. Homeward bound, complete your journey with an exclusive alpine snow landing for the ultimate Milford Sound experience. Will back to Queenstown at late afternoon.

Morning Arrive in Hong Kong.

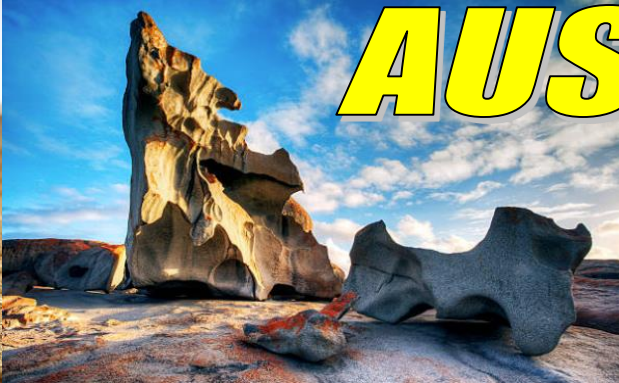

11 Days / 10 Nights

Adelaide, Kangaroo Island, Sydney

Day 01 Hong Kong – Adelaide

Evening flight departure to Adelaide. Overnight on board.

Day 02 Adelaide at leisure

Arrive Adelaide in the morning.

Meet by our representative and transfer to check-in at hotel. The rest of the day is free at leisure on your own. Stay overnight in Adelaide.

Day 03 Adelaide – Kangaroo Island

Early breakfast at hotel. Hotel will arrange a box of breakfast at 6:00am and will be ready to collect at Concierge Desk. Departing from hotel at 6:45am the tour makes its way to the Kangaroo Island Sealink Ferry located at Cape Jervis. The drive to Cape Jervis takes around 1.5 hours and travels the length of the Fleurieu Peninsula, which has wonderful coastal and country scenery.

9:00am Departs Port in Cape Jervis to Penneshaw

9:45am Arrive Kangaroo-Penneshaw.

On arrival the tour heads for the south coast of the island towards Seal Bay Conservation Park - Home to 600 Australian Sea Lions where you enjoy a full commentary from the accredited guide as you walk amongst and observe these marvelous creatures at rest, play and while nursing their young. Then onto Little Sahara - Vast sand dunes of the Island's inland desert before continuing to Parndana Wildlife Park which acts as a refuge for sick or orphaned animals offering a unique, hands on experience. The park is home to a diverse range of Australian wildlife, some of which are endangered and found only on Kangaroo Island. Stop for a gourmet picnic lunch with South Australian beers and wines. Head to Snellings Beach before continuing to Stokes Bay with its secluded white sands divided by arched rock formations. End your Day with a visit to Latham Conservation Park, home of the rare glossy black cockatoo, wallabies and the elusive echidna.

Transfer to your hotel and stay overnight in Kangaroo Island.

Day 04 Kangaroo Island

Breakfast at hotel. Hotel pick-up and drop off transfer service included. Your tour starts with the Rocky River, Headquarters of Flinders Chase National Park. The Chase is home to a variety of Australian native animals and birds including kangaroos and Cape Barren geese. Continue onto Admirals Arch - An ancient limestone formation and haul-out area for an active colony of New Zealand fur seals. Your journey continues with the Remarkable Rocks at Cape de Couedic. Also enjoy a short bush walk in search of the echidna (Spiny Ant Eater), koalas and the colorful Kangaroo Island endemic crimson rosellas. Enjoy lunch, a traditional Aussie Barbeque with South Australian beers and wines. Then its back on the road to Koala Avenue where you take a scenic stroll and enjoy a rare experience to see koalas in their natural environment. 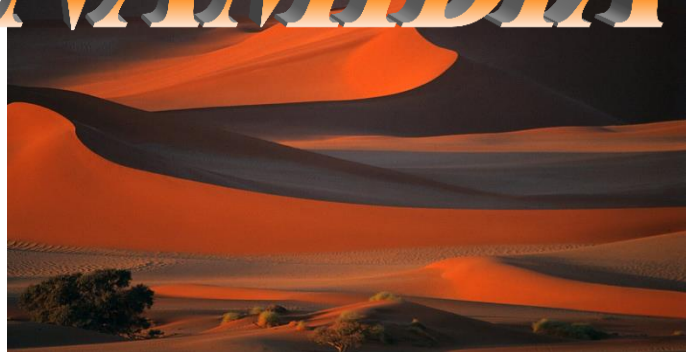


ZIMBABWE

Check in the hotel and overnight.

Day 4

Plitvicka Jezera (Lake area) – Zadar (140kms – Approx. 2 hrs drive)

Breakfast at hotel. Check out. Morning walk around the **Plitvicka Lake National Park**. Then drive 2hrs towards **Zadar**. Upon arrival in Zadar have a walking tour with local English speaking guide to visit this ancient Croatian city which inherited diverse architectural sights from its long and turbulent history as the church of St Donat, originally built in 9th century in Byzantine style. Another landmark is the cathedral of St Anastasia constructed in the 12th and 13th centuries in Romanesque style. Then check in to the hotel and overnight.

Zadar – Sibenik – Trogir – Split (170kms – approx. 3 hrs drive)

Early morning departure to Split with en-route stop in the city of **Sibenik** (one hour drive), have walking tour with local English speaking guide to visit the famous cathedral of St James (UNESCO World Heritage List since 2000). Next stop will be **Trogir** (one hour drive), have walking tour with local English speaking guide to visit the town museum (UNESCO World Heritage List since 1997). Then drive 50mins toward to **Split**. Upon arrival, Check in at Hotel. Free and overnight at hotel. Lunch & dinner on guest own account.

Day 6

Split – Ston – Dubrovnik (260kms – approx. 4 hrs drive)

After early breakfast at hotel. Have walking tour with local English speaking guide to visit the historical center in Split, **Diocletian's Palace remains** (UNESCO World Heritage List since 1979). Then drive 3hrs to **Ston**. The Dubrovnik Republic built the town of Ston in the 14th century in the form of a two-fold fortification system (Large and Small Ston), aiming to protect the salt plants, one of its major economic resources. Then continue drive one hour to **Dubrovnik** and check in the hotel. Free and overnight at hotel. Lunch & dinner on guest own account.

Day 7

Dubrovnik (Breakfast)

Breakfast at hotel. Morning have half-day tour with local English speaking guide for visiting the **Old City of Dubrovnik**, surrounded by city walls built between the 13th and 16th centuries which is one of the UNESCO World Heritage Site listed since 1979. 12 Days / 11 Nights: Ulaanbaatar / Lake Khuvsgul / South Gobi (Departs every Tue/Thu/Fri & Sun.)

DAY 1 Hong Kong / Ulaanbaatar

Noon flight departure for a direct flight to Ulaanbaatar. Meet representative and transfer to have welcome dinner at local restaurant. Then check-in at your hotel. Free and overnight.

DAY 2 Fly to Khuvsgul Province – Lake Khuvsgul

Today you are transferred to the airport for the flight to Moron, either in morning or afternoon depending on the domestic flight schedule. The flight from Ulaanbaatar to the capital of the Khuvsgul Province will take one and a half hours, and your guide will accompany you. On arrival at Moron you will be met by a local driver and jeep. You will be driven north towards Lake Khuvsgul. The drive is about 140 km and will take about 5-6 hours. The highest altitude is 2300m. On arrival at the lake you will be taken to check in your ger camp. Dinner and over night

Day 3 Lake Khuvsgul

Spend one full day by the lake. There will be time for hiking in the surrounding hills, swimming or kayaking in the lake, or just gazing out over the vast blue expanse of water. You will be staying at the ger camp and all meals will be at the camp. For lunch there will be the option of taking a packed lunch out with you. Dinner and over night

DAY 4 Return to Ulaanbaatar

Today will have an early start in order to get back to Moron in time for the flight to Ulaanbaatar. On arrival in Ulaanbaatar you will be met by a driver and vehicle and taken back to your hotel in Ulaanbaatar.

DAY 5 Ulaanbaatar – Baga Khentii Mountains

After breakfast you will have some time for shopping and a trip to the Fine Arts Museum by your own arrangement. You will be met by your driver in the early afternoon, and head east of the capital to Maikhan Tolgoi. These hills are situated at the border of the Terelj National Park. The drive is about 1 hour from the capital. On arrival you will be check in the ger camp and have lunch there. It is located in a beautiful spot, and is close to a nomadic family. The afternoon is at your leisure for riding and hiking in the mountains. Dinner and overnight at ger camp

DAY 6 Ulaanbaatar – Horseback trek

In the morning, there will be an organized trek on horseback for three or four hours. A nomadic horseman will accompany you and you will have time to relax and enjoy the natural surroundings. There are a lot of mountain flowers, especially edelweiss, and you can spend time hiking alone through the forested hillsides, among beautiful streams with crystal flowing waters, observing and visiting the nomadic families in the vicinity. In the afternoon you will be transferred back to your hotel in Ulaanbaatar for dinner and the night.

Travel Season is from June to September where July and August are the best time to visit Mongolia.



DAY 7 Fly to South Gobi – Yolyn Am ice gorge

Today you are transferred to the airport for the flight to the South Gobi Province, either in the morning or the afternoon depending on the domestic flight schedule. The flight takes one and a half hours, and on arrival at the airstrip in the Gobi a local driver will meet you and will take you to Yolyn Am, or 'Eagle Valley'. This is about 40km from your ger camp and will take about one hour's drive. The valley is about 10km long and is completely shaded from the sun in some parts by high cliff walls. It is possible to walk through the valley and out the other side. You may be lucky enough to spot wild sheep and goats grazing high on the cliff walls. The valley is also full of soaring eagles hunting for prey. At the opening of the valley is a Natural History Museum displaying interesting information about the animals in the area. We will have dinner and stay for the night at the ger camp.

DAY 8 Khongoriin Els Sand Dunes

Today we will make an early start to the Khongoriin Els sand-dunes. They are about 220km from the provincial center, and the drive will take 7-8 hours. These are Mongolia's largest sand-dunes. You will have a packed lunch on the way. After a long day of driving, we will have dinner and set up tented camp by the sand dunes to overnight.

DAY 9 Camel ride through the Sand Dunes

Today we will be riding on camels to explore these massive sand-dunes, which rise to a height of 800 meters in some places. The two-humped Bactrian camels are very comfortable to ride as they walk slowly and gently, and we will be well supported by the humps, sitting comfortably between them. Our camel man will lead the way through the sand dunes. We will take lunch with us and ride back to the camp in the evening.

DAY 10 'Flaming Cliffs' of Bayanzag

Today we will be driven back to the Gobi ger camp, near Dalanzadgad, for dinner and overnight. We will make an early start and on the way back we will visit the "Flaming Cliffs" of Bayanzag. Bayanzag is an area of red cliffs, which were formed by the erosion of the sand and rock over many thousands of years. It is also the site of several successful dinosaur excavations. The drive to Bayanzag from the ger camp will take about one hour and you will see some wide, open desert scenery on the way. Packed lunch on the way. Return to the camp site to enjoy the dinner and overnight.

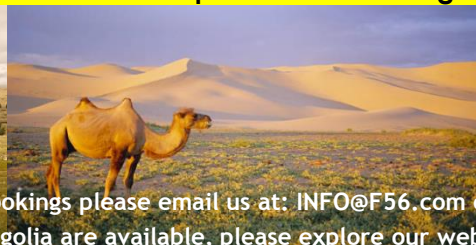
DAY 11 Sightseeing in Ulaanbaatar

After a relaxed, late breakfast you will be driven to the desert airstrip with your guide for your return flight to Ulaanbaatar. At the airport in Ulaanbaatar you will be met by our vehicle and transferred to the hotel. 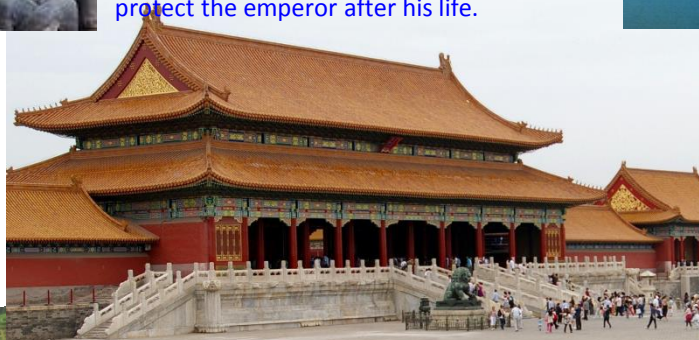

The Terra Cotta – collection of sculptures depicting the armies of Qin Shi Huang, the first Emperor of China around 210–209 BC and whose purpose was to protect the emperor after his life.



BEIJING - the capital of China, has its history stretching back 3 millennia. Known for its modern architecture as well as its ancient sites such as the grand Forbidden City complex, the imperial palace during the Ming and Qing dynasties, is the largest ancient palatial structure in the world



Beijing is also the destination to admire the iconic “The Great Wall” sections - Badaling and Mutianyu, the renovated Juyonguan, Jinshanling and Simatai, and wild Jiankou and Gubeikou. They are all not far from the city.

GUILIN - one of the best known tourist destination in China, for its dramatic landscape of limestone karst hills along the Li River. Also a gateway to Longji Rice Terraces, which is located in Longsheng County, only a short distance from Guilin.



HANGZHOU - the capital of Zhejiang province, is the southern terminus of the Grand Canal. West Lake – the pride of the city, celebrated by poets and artists since the 9th century. There are numerous temples, pagodas, gardens, and artificial islands. The city is not far from SHANGHAI – a populous financial centre.
